A large painting on the south wall of the church is by St Mary's parishioner, Jacqueline Johns, created and hung in 2010. Stylized members of the Parish Family are depicted, at the baptism of an adult. The figures are faceless and black, to represent both anonymity and racial inclusivity. Members of the Koori and South Sudanese Community of our Parish have found the painting very meaningful.
