"The Creation" Window

The third window on the north side of the church is a beautiful window crafted again by the local Churchill artists Vi and Geoffrey Biram.

The bottom of the window depicts the beginning of Creation with God's light dividing the primeval darkness. The Word of God (or Logos) speaks into and through Creation and so land begins to emerge from the waters of chaos. Life forms also emerge and are interwoven with chromosome symbols (the rod-like structures) representing the ongoing evolution of life. Tree branches and birds top the sky and then above all this are the sun and the moon and planets. Right at the top, as the peak of Creation, are the symbols of man and woman depicted under the arch of God's continuing love and nurture in the form of a blue rainbow.
